9:00 a.m.-12:00 noon. Orientation Check-in

(Blackwell Hall, Foyer) After clearance at check-in, students may move into their respective residence halls. **Students will not be allowed to move into the residence halls until receiving a clearance pass; therefore, you MUST come to check-in first.** Any new student not cleared will be directed to the appropriate office(s) for clearance.

Check-in includes:

- x **Admissions, Financial Aid and the Business Office** are all located in Blackwell Hall and will be open during orientation check-in.

- x **Security**- Vehicle registration. Bring your drivers license and vehicle registration to check-in.
