Dear Student (s),

I wanted to take a moment and explain why we have implemented a \$100.00 charge for the parking decal for next year. This will allow the college to continue to provide an extra security officer for 40 hours per week to patrol the residential facilities. We realize that economic times are tough all over, but we are committed to providing this extra layer of security for our most valuable resources, our students.

All students, residential and commuter, must register their cars to park on campus. If you are not bringing a car to campus, you will need to fill out a waiver form stating that you do not and will not have a car on campus. Unregistered cars will be ticketed and possibly towed, so PLEASE do not avoid registering your car.

You can register your car, online at our home page or at a SOAR program during the summer if you are a new student, and returning students can register and send in the fee (checks only) by mail or the first day back in the fall at the campus security office.

We have enclosed a registration form with instructions and a waiver form in this package for your convenience. Please fill it out completely, include the \$100.00 fee, NO cash please, and send it back in the enclosed envelope. Your parking decal will be in your on campus post office box when you arrive on campus for the new and returning students.
